RE: Pretreatment Enforcement Response Plan & Changes to Chapter 51 of the Village Code

The proposed ordinance changes to the Village's pretreatment ordinance are a requirement of the Village's NPDES permit and are largely based on the EPA Model Ordinance for pretreatment (January 2007). The latest version of the model ordinance incorporates the requirements of the Streamlining Rule for the National Pretreatment Program (40 CFR 403) which became effective in November 2005.

The attached February 2006 EPA Fact Sheet document outlines the significant changes to pretreatment programs per the Streamlining Rule. The majority of these changes are related to the reporting, sampling, and documentation by Significant Industrial Users (SIU) and the Village. Note that Publicly-Owned Treatment Works (POTW) like Itasca are not required to implement some of the changes, and these items have been stricken on the Fact Sheet and are not included in the new ordinance.

Also attached is a copy of the Pretreatment Enforcement Response Plan with the new revisions highlighted in yellow.
