2. Itasca Historic District Projects Review

2A. Stephen and Eileen Ellenbecker Fence Review – 260 North Oak Street and 308 West Center Street

Stephen and Eileen Ellenbecker, 260 North Oak Street, appeared before the Commission to present plans for a new fence at 260 North Oak Street and 308 West Center Street. The plans are to extend an existing 4' solid fence north along the west side of 208 West Center Street from where it currently ends at the Center Street sidewalk and to add a 4' 50% open fence along the sidewalk on the north sides of 208 West Center Street and 260 North Oak Street. The new fence sections will connect at the northwest corner of 260 North Oak Street. Older sections of the existing 4' solid fence will be replaced. The color of the new fence will match the existing fence's almond color. Commissioner Douglas moved to approve the fence as submitted with an option of allowing the picket to extend 6" through the top rail if variance not approved by Plan Commission; Commissioner Machynia seconded. All were in favor. Motion approved.
