1. Call to Order

The June 5, 2018 regular meeting of the Village Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:10 p.m. by Village Clerk Conidi.

Residents addressed the Village Board regarding Subtropical Storm Alberto causing heavy rainfall in Itasca on Wednesday, May 30, 2018. President Pro Temp Aiani requested each speaker for their contact information in order for the Village to visit properties for follow up.

Itasca resident Robbie Whitehead, 604 North Elm Street, received water in his yard and basement, and thanked Mayor Pruyn and Village Administrator Ergo for going through the community Wednesday. Mr. Whitehead wanted to start the conversation for fixing any drainage issues in his area.

Itasca resident Gina Pezza, 608 North Elm Street, reported for the first time in eight years receiving 2½ feet of water in her basement with water pouring over the window wells and back door.

Itasca resident Anthony Santoro, 528 North Willow Street, and owner of Tree Guys Pizza Pub, 101 East Irving Park Road, thanked the Village stating water went right into the storm sewers after his area had flooded in the past.

President Pro Temp Aiani reported 38 residences contacted the Village about flooding and there are steps homeowners and the Village can do to alleviate reoccurring flooding. All residences who contacted the Village will be visited and steps taken to help future flooding, and the Village will continue to monitor flooding. The flooding levels from the storm rose quickly but went down quickly compared to flooding in the past.
