SUBJECT: Update to the Liquor License Ordinance, Section 112.20

Introduction

The purpose of this Ordinance is to update the Liquor License Ordinance.

Discussion

The Village Board has a long-standing practice of issuing liquor licenses to various establishments to allow for the sale of alcohol. The purpose of this license is to ensure that business owners adhere to the rules established by the Board regarding those who sell alcohol as well as the style in which it is served. To ensure proper enforcement of the licenses, staff has found it necessary to request an update to the Liquor License Ordinance, section 112.20 – Number of Licenses.

Recently, Village staff received a request from Church Street Brewing to upgrade their Class C liquor license to a Class C-1 license. Under the Class C-1 liquor license, Church Street will be able to serve liquor and wine, which is not permitted under a Class C license. Currently, there are no open Class C-1 licenses available, as the Village Board recently reduced the number of licenses to zero after the relocation of Itasca Brewery.

Fiscal Impact

The Village can expect to see an increase in revenue under the food & beverage tax, as well as under its liquor license revenues. Under the code, a Class C-1 liquor license fee is \$2,200, compared to the Class C license, which is \$1,100 per year.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends the item be forwarded to the Village Board meeting on November 23, 2021, for discussion and approval. Should Church Street's request be approved, the Board will need to amend the number of Class C licenses from one to zero and increase the number of Class C-1 licenses from zero to one.
