Dear Resident:

Bloomington Road is scheduled to be closed in the eastbound direction starting June 27, 2022. The eastbound traffic will be detoured, and Bloomington Road will become a one-way road in the westbound direction from Irving Park Road to IL-53 (Rohlwing Road). Traffic control barrels and signage will designate the one-way westbound direction. The one-way detour is anticipated to be in place for the duration of the project (through November 30, 2022).

The detour is required to facilitate the reconstruction of the roadway while providing a safe work environment for this project. The detour will have proper signage, including one-way arrows. Residents are encouraged to utilize the other side streets to navigate to Irving Park Road during the construction. Access to the north and south cross streets will remain open. Please use extra CAUTION when traveling through the construction zone.

The reconstruction and resurfacing of Bloomington Road will occur from Irving Park Road to IL-53 (Rohlwing Road). The project will consist of reconstruction and resurfacing of Bloomington Road consisting of pavement widening, installation of curb and gutter, storm sewer improvements, culvert improvements and stamped asphalt cross walks. A portion of Bloomington Road, near the bridge over I-290, is maintained by Addison Township and will remain a rural cross section with roadside ditches.

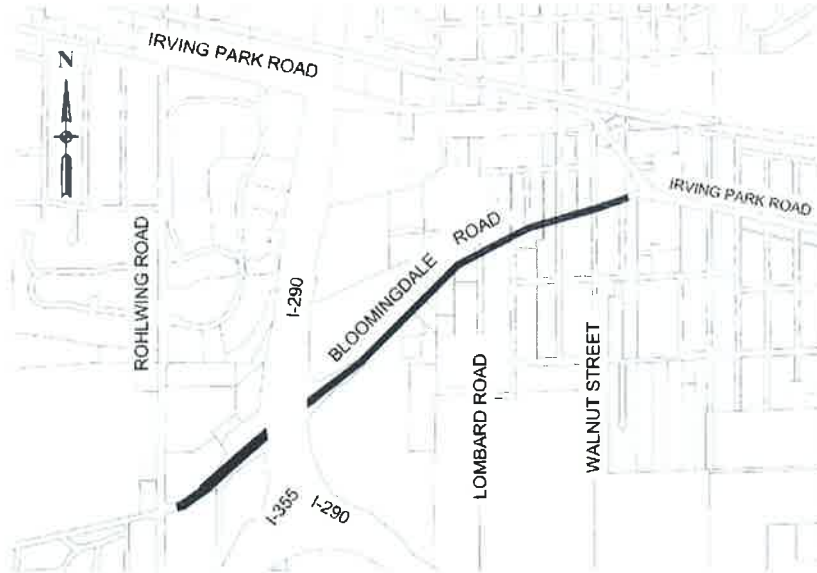

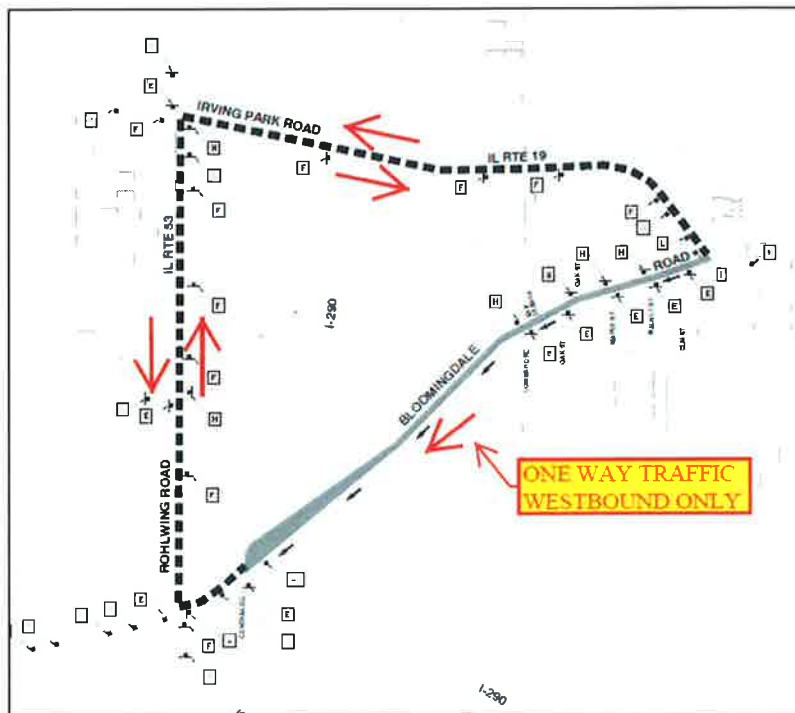
Paving Heavy Construction Site Development Grading

Limits of Bloomingdale Road Project



The reconstruction of Bloomingdale Road will have a significant impact on travel in the area. Due to the reconstruction, Bloomingdale Road will require a detour route and will only have one-way traffic during the duration of the project. One-Way traffic in the west-bound direction will be maintained from Irving Park Road to IL-53. There will be no eastbound traffic on Bloomingdale Road beyond Central Road. North and south cross street access and driveways along Bloomingdale Road will be maintained during construction with temporary aggregate. Residents in the area that want to travel eastbound will need to follow the detour route west to IL-53 to Irving Park Road or utilize local roads to maneuver around the construction area.

DETOUR ROUTE



What to Expect:

- Utility work (ComEd, MCI, etc.) along the Bloomingdale Road corridor has been taking place over the past month or two in preparation of the reconstruction project, this work will continue. Tree removal operations were completed to allow relocation of utilities and aerial lines. Additional vegetation pruning will also take place to facilitate construction.
- Heavy Construction Equipment, material deliveries, material storage in parkways and construction noise will be present from 7:00 AM to dusk daily.
- Use CAUTION in and around the construction site.
- **On JUNE 27, the detour route will be implemented. Only ONE-WAY traffic in the Westbound (South) direction will be allowed, refer to detour route exhibit above.**

ANTICIPATED SCHEDULE

(Subject to weather and/or unanticipated delays)

- **Pre-Stage Construction (Project preparation)**
Anticipated dates: JUNE 27 through JULY 6, 2022
 - One-way westbound traffic only will be along the north side of the existing roadway.
 - Temporary pavement will be constructed along the south edge of the existing roadway to provide the required width for one-way traffic during the reconstruction process. The width of the temporary pavement will vary from 2 feet to 12 feet at various locations.
 - Tree removal was completed to allow relocation of utilities and aerial utility lines.
 - Utility and drainage improvements will be installed at various locations.
 - Partial Driveway aprons along the **SOUTH SIDE** of the road will be sawcut and removed to accommodate the temporary pavement along the south side of the road.
 - Temporary aggregate will be placed to allow continued driveway access.
 - Access to your driveways will be maintained with the exception of when work is occurring at your driveway location.
 - R.W. Dunteman will notify you 48 hours in advance if your driveway will be out of service.
 - Mail Delivery will be coordinated with the post office.
- **Stage 1 – Construction (Re-construction of new WB Bloomingdale Road infrastructure)**
Anticipated dates: JULY 7 through SEPTEMBER 6, 2022
 - One-way westbound traffic will shift to the south side of the existing roadway and temporary pavement to allow reconstruction of the north half of the roadway to commence.
 - Utility and drainage improvements will be installed along the north side of Bloomingdale Road.
 - Existing pavement of the north half of the roadway will be removed. New curb & gutter and roadway pavement will be constructed along the north half of the roadway.
 - Coordination with residents will be a priority to allow construction of new curb & gutter through drives and to minimize time needed for driveway closures.
 - Driveway aprons along the **NORTH SIDE** of the road will be removed and reconstructed.
 - Temporary aggregate will be placed to maintain driveway access as much as possible.
 - Access to your driveways will be maintained except for when work is occurring at your driveway location, or when new curb and gutter and driveway aprons are installed.
 - Coordination with residents will be a priority to allow removal and reconstruction of new driveway aprons. Grading of the north parkway between the right-of-way to the new curb will be completed, preparation for final landscape restoration.
 - R.W. Dunteman will notify you 48 hours in advance if your driveway will be out of service.
 - Mail Delivery will be coordinated with the post office.
- **Stage 2 – Construction (Re-construction of new EB Bloomingdale Road infrastructure)**
Anticipated dates: SEPTEMBER 7 through NOVEMBER 9, 2022
 - One-way westbound traffic will shift to the newly constructed north side of the roadway.

- Utility and drainage improvements will be installed along the south side of Bloomingdale Road.
 - Existing pavement of the south half of the roadway will be removed.
 - Remaining driveway aprons on the SOUTH SIDE will be removed and reconstructed.
 - Temporary aggregate will be placed to maintain driveway access as much as possible.
 - Access to your driveways will be maintained except for when work is occurring at your driveway location, or when new curb and gutter and driveway aprons are installed.
 - New curb & gutter and roadway pavement will be constructed along the south side of the roadway.
 - Coordination with residents will be a priority to allow construction of new curb & gutter through drives and to minimize time needed for driveway closures.
 - Grading of the south parkway between from the right-of-way to the new curb will be completed, preparation for final landscape restoration.
- **Stage 3 – Construction (Grinding and resurfacing of western portion of project; approximately 260 ft. east of Rohlwing Road to approximately 1000 ft. east of Bloomingdale Road bridge over I-290 (bridge deck is gapped as part of the project))**
Anticipated dates: NOVEMBER 10 through NOVEMBER 30, 2022
 - One-way traffic detour will be removed, new pavement open to EB and WB Bloomingdale Road traffic.
 - Grinding of the resurfacing portion of the roadway will be done under flagging operations which will allow for two-way traffic.
 - Final surface course will be placed over the entire project roadway.
 - Due to utility delays, final surfacing may not be complete by the end of November. In this case, Bloomingdale road will be reopened to 2-way traffic starting December 1. Road closure and final surfacing will resume and complete in early spring 2023.

Notes

- Final landscaping and restoration (seed and blanket) will be performed in both north and south parkways.
- Properties along Bloomingdale Road will have their driveway apron removed and replaced as part of the construction. If your driveway is affected, there will be a time during construction when you may not have access to your driveway during working hours when construction activity occurs. However, in no case should your driveway be out of service overnight, except for when any new concrete driveway and/or curb is poured to allow proper time for the concrete to cure which may be for a period of three (3) to five (5) days. During this time, you may need to park any cars you may want to use along the neighboring streets. R.W. Dunteman will notify residents 48 hours in advance of when they will not have access to their driveways. Any scheduled deliveries or other issues may be coordinated by contacting Robinson Engineering resident construction engineer.
